New Effect: TC Reverb: VSS4

Presets: Save and overwrite dialogue pop-up

• Presets: Insert patching can be stored and loaded separate to whole system

• Tap Tempo: Pop-up dialogue to type in speed and rate

• Overview/GUI: Automation scenes now displayed in console overview/default for Pro X

• Preferences: 'Output meters pre' option - distinct from Input meters pre (previous global)

Option to isolate surface navigation buttons
Option to isolate Area B with automate paging

Automation: Scope Key available for Pro X

Show Editor: Mutes and Faders now available as separate options

• Patching: Fixed issue where CM-1 output patching did not update between scenes

Additional Information

How to install the offline editor on OSX

- 1. Copy the file to an Apple Macintosh computer
- 2. Double-click the file
- 3. Accept the license agreement
- 4. Then drag the Midas Offline Editor icon onto the "Drop here to install" icon
- 5. The program is then automatically installed and can be clicked to start it

How to install the offline editor on OSX

- Apple Mac with OSX 10.11 (El Capitan) or above
- 4GB RAM
- 500MB HDD available



Operational Considerations

- Please ensure you Mac settings are configured to allow third party applications to be installed
- If application fails to launch first time running program please try the following
 - Use secondary click (right click) on the Offline Editor in the Application folder
 - Select "Open" from drop down menu
 - In the pop-up warning box click "Open" again
 - Application can be launched normally from now on
