

## Behringer WING Series Firmware

### Version 3.0.6 (24 Apr 2025)

WING firmware 3.0.6 introduces workflow improvements and enhancements for integration with the P24 personal monitoring system.

With each firmware update, a specific firmware file for each WING model is provided (WING, WING COMPACT or WING RACK).

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** If you are using the WING-DANTE expansion card or the internal AoIP-Dante module, you must also update the module's firmware. Firmware files and update instructions are available on the product page and in the general downloads section.

#### **New Features:**

- Source name transmission over StageConnect
- Hold down the HA REMOTE / RCV CUST button to apply settings to all sources in the selected group
- Hold down STOP option button to apply settings to the whole clip playlist
- AES50 error counter on the SETUP > AUDIO screen to help identify faulty cables and connections. (COR = corrected; UNC = uncorrected)
- WING COMPACT only: hold down any CC button and turn the rotary encoder below the main meter to adjust FX parameters.
- Reset EQ band by holding down the band selection button
- SD recorder error messages shown in text form
- CC button options to change CC bank

#### **Changed:**

- Solo (POST) follows panning on INPUT and AUX channel, and DCAs
- WING-LIVE displays a warning message if recording dropouts occur due to a slow SD card

**Fixed:**

- Toolbox "IN" copy option not available for all channel type combinations
- CC assigned to SD recorder session list or marker list not working correctly on long sessions
- CC display not updated when switching CC banks while a CC is held down
- Sporadic audio clicks when using Dante
- Short streams of digital zeros in transmitted audio when using Dante (when WING is Dante clock leader) (BRK2 modules only)
- Function could not be deactivated when using GPIO to set fixed fader levels.
- TAP WIDTH not stored in SNIPPETS
