But here, in the Glass House Mountains, there are 11 to explore. You'll want to carve out some time in villages like Maleny, Montville and Mapleton where the streets are lined with cafés slinging local produce and epic art galleries, as well as Kenilworth, a little country town packing a whole lot of charm. At night, fall asleep to the sound of the rainforest in your tranquil retreat - bliss.

The southern belle of the Sunshine Coast, Caloundra is a laid-back coastal town where the locals will greet you with a warm welcome and the natural beauty is endless. Need even more beach? Head over to neighbouring Mooloolaba consistently voted one of Queensland's best beaches. Here the action starts at the Esplanade, so start your day by taking your taste buds on a tour of the best local cafés - before throwing yourself into the sparkling ocean and body surfing the perfect rolling waves. Looking for a place to eat? The Wharf Mooloolaba has you covered, with a range of epic bars and restaurants right on the sparkling waters of the Mooloolah River.

DON'T MISS

Enjoy fresh seafood off the trawler at one of the fish and chipperies (The Spit Mooloolaba is abuzz with them)! Get your walking shoes on and take a coastal walk from Moffat Beach to Bulcock Beach. Start your day with a sunrise swim in Mooloolaba. Pick up a paddle board and

explore Pumicestone Passage.

Slow things down with a paddle along the Maroochy River, stroll along the coast between Cotton Tree and Alexandra Headland or see the coastline from a different perspective with a scenic flight or river cruise. Hungry? Make a beeline to Ocean Street where you'll find a hub of delicious restaurants and buzzing bars. Finally, give your wallet (and legs) a workout at the Sunshine Coast's largest shopping centre, Sunshine Plaza. While its neighbours might be more hustle and bustle, further north at Coolum Beach unwinding and unplugging isn't just encouraged, it's a way of life. Fringed by grassy beachfronts, parks, and pristine waters, your days here will be spent soaking up the great outdoors.

DON'T MISS

Catch the sunset (or sunrise!) from the top of Mount Coolum. Head to Giddy Geisha in Maroochydore for their eggplant chips – watch out they are addictive! Stroll the boardwalk in Coolum for the perfect photo with the beach as your backdrop. Explore Cotton Tree Beach, one of the best places to have

The perfect Noosa holiday is made up of four key ingredients - balmy beach days, breathtaking coastal walks, good food and relaxed vibes. For many, a Noosa escape starts at Noosa Heads, where pristine nature hugs the iconic, tree-lined Hastings Street. Beyond the beach, Noosa is home to one of only two everglades systems in the world and postcard perfect hinterland villages you need to add to your itinerary.

Shop your heart out at the Eumundi Markets. Exploring the lush oasis of Noosa National Park on foot. Catch a wave at Noosa's World Surfing Reserve (10th in the world).

Q GYMPIE AND RAINBOW BEACH

Nestled in the middle of the breathtaking Great Sandy Biosphere is the Gympie Region - an area awash with natural beauty that's just waiting to be discovered. To the east of the region you'll find the Cooloola Coast, home to the sparkling waters of Rainbow Beach and Tin Can Bay and the closest gateway to K'gari (Fraser Island). To the west are the pioneering towns of Kilkivan and Goomeri. To the south, you'll find the lush rural communities of the Mary Valley, home to a cluster of beautiful country villages, trails and drives that will have you whipping out your phone and taking a snap before you can say 'wow.'

DON'T MISS

Surf Australia's longest wave at Double Island Point. Jump in a 4WD for a drive along the great sandy highway of Rainbow Beach. Traverse through rural country villages aboard the Mary Valley Rattler. Take in a stunning sunset at Carlo Sandblow.

ON THE SUNSHINE COAST, WE'RE NESTLED IN NATURE AND GREEN AT HEART. WE CARE ABOUT OUR ENVIRONMENT, FROM THE SPARKLING COASTLINE TO LUSH RAINFORESTS.

In fact, we're the only destination in the world where you'll find three UNESCO Biosphere Reserves sitting side-by-side. Here you'll find some of Australia's most pristine natural environments, like the Noosa Everglades - one of only two everglades systems on Earth - is a 60km stretch of sparkling waterways, fringed by ancient tea tree forests and floating lily pads. We also have more than 100km pristine beaches, pockets of subtropical rainforest and the ancient peaks of the Glass House Mountains that are actually remnants of volcanic activity that occurred more than 25 million years ago.

STRETCHING FOR MORE THAN 100KM, THE SUNSHINE COAST IS HOME TO SOME OF THE BEST BEACHES IN THE WORLD. AND THE BEST PART? HERE, YOU CAN SWIM YEAR-ROUND AND BEST ENJOYED IN THE RIGHT CONDITIONS.

With a sunny laidback vibe and quality waves, the Sunshine Coast is a worldclass surfers' playground. If you are after more of an adrenaline rush, soar over the glassy ocean on a jet ski or hydrofoil, or set a slower pace paddling through our crystal clear waters on a kayak.

From June to October, swim alongside the majestic humpback whales with the crew at Sunreef Mooloolaba or, if you prefer to keep your feet dry, jump aboard one of the many whale watching vessels. If snorkelling is more your thing, Mudjimba Island, accessible by boat, is the place to swim alongside the island's locals - dolphins, turtles, stingrays, crayfish, wobbegongs, eels and starfish.

Discover one of the best dive wreck sites in Australia, the Ex-HMAS Brisbane. Further north, Wolf Rock dive site is the only known gestation site for Grey Nurse Sharks on Australia's East Coast and has been classified as a marine sanctuary.


