We understand that your time is valuable and in order to process your account opening request as quickly and efficiently as possible we ask that you provide information outlined below with which we will prepare documentation in advance of the meeting time to be confirmed with you.

Vancity is a member owned co-operative; a \$5.00 share deposit is required, which stays with the account until the account is closed.

## Section 1 – Required Documents

To open a **Sole Proprietorship** business account the following information and documentation is required in order to comply with all Legislative and Credit Union policies. Provide the following:

*Note:* The Corporate Registry will allow an incorporated company to register a Sole Proprietorship name. Vancity's policy is to treat this as a 'Trade Name' registration whereby we will open the account as a Corporation with a registered trade name.

## **Registration - Business Name Information**

In BC, a Sole Proprietorship must be registered:

- if the individuals name is not used in the business name,
- if there is a suggestion of plurality. Plurality means that the chosen name includes words that indicate a number of persons involved in the business (e.g. & Sons; and Company; and Associates). Businesses with names including these terms must be registered at the B.C. Corporate Registry.

The business name should (but does not have to) have a "distinctive" element and a "descriptive" element. The former makes the business name unique (sole proprietors name) whereas the latter describes the type of business.

## Name formats that do not require registration

- James W. Smith Plumbing does not have to be registered. Principal clearly identified.
- James Smith DBA Smith Plumbing does not have to be registered, as long as this full name is used on all signage, advertising, invoices and other public documents. If only Smith Plumbing is used, it must be registered.
- James Smith is legally valid but is not recommended as it does not have a descriptive element (e.g.

Plumbing).
