Investigators Featured at Fall Meeting

One of the highlights of our November 18, 2021 Fall Advisory Group Meeting was the opportunity to learn about the research being conducted by Devesha Kulkarni, Ph.D. and Alex Holehouse, Ph.D., both second-year recipients of LLF support. Dr. Kulkarni discussed her investigation into the role of gut microbiota in obesity, and Dr. Holehouse presented about his work into predicting the impact of genetic variations within intrinsically disordered protein regions.
