About CGSS

When combined with 18 months to two years of financial crime compliance experience, earning the Certified Global Sanctions Specialist Certification (CGSS) means that an individual has the knowledge necessary to manage the risk of and comply with regulations related to sanctions compliance.

CGSS has been developed in conjunction with recognized sanctions experts and anti-financial crime (AFC) subject matter experts, including those from regulatory and law enforcement backgrounds. CGSS answers the need for an in-depth program in sanctions compliance that can be deployed to teams globally, to help them address sanctions risk, ensuring their workforce is properly trained and their specialized knowledge is recognized.

This sanctions compliance certification program enables organizations to address sanctions risk, establish an effective sanctions compliance program, and demonstrate compliance with regulatory requirements.

Who Is CGSS For?

CGSS is ideal for mid- to senior-level professionals working in the field of sanctions and/or, more broadly, in AFC compliance.

3. Detecting and Investigating Sanctions Evasion Techniques

Learn about sanctions evasion techniques through ownership, trade, and payments, including how to investigate sanctions breaches and manage the freezing of assets

4. Sanctions Compliance Case Studies

Consolidate your knowledge with case studies and activities designed for practitioners

Candidates will also receive additional materials to help them confidently prepare for the CGSS exam.

The CGSS Exam

Candidates have 175 minutes to complete the CGSS exam. The exam contains 100 multiple choice and multiple select questions.

The CGSS study materials will equip candidates with the relevant concepts and knowledge, enabling them to prepare for the certification exam with confidence.

Candidate Requirements

Candidates need approximately 18 months to two years of AFC work experience - ideally in the sanctions space.

To be eligible for the CGSS exam you must have 40 eligibility credits based on education, other professional certifications, and/or professional experience related to financial crime prevention.

- Access to the ACAMS community and AFC resources to continue your professional development

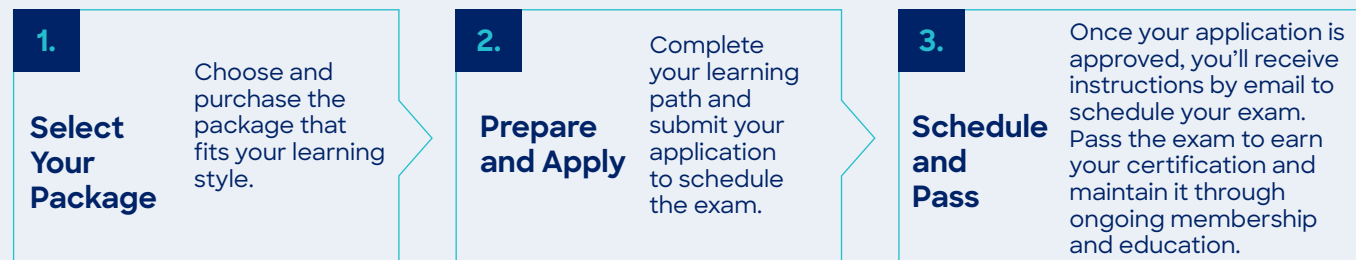
