Force Multiply Your Officers

Features

Post-Incident Narration

Officers can add context to provide essential details that the transcript alone may not capture. By typing or narrating, this information is combined with transcripts, or used on its own, to generate a stronger first draft.

Enhance Officer Safety

Writing reports in the field can reduce your officers' situational awareness. With Draft One, your officers spend less time focused on their devices, reducing their time in a vulnerable position and enhancing officer safety.

Generate Higher Quality Reports

Improve the quality of your agency's reports with consistent grammar, spelling, and clarity. Provide concise summaries for supervisors, the justice system, and other key reviewers.

Usage Reports

Track Draft One usage across your agency with self-service reports. See user-level insights into the number of drafts generated and reports submitted or copied to identify champions and target training.

Ethics-First Design

Draft One was rigorously evaluated for word choice selection, draft quality and racial bias. Draft One also contains a number of safeguards developed in partnership with a wide variety of stakeholders, including the Ethics & Equity Advisory Council (EEAC).

Adjustable Draft Lengths

Customize the level of detail in your reports by choosing a preferred draft length when generating your report. Select from short, standard, or more detail to fit the need of each incident.

Rapid Audio Upload and Transcription

Audio from Axon BWC footage is uploaded over LTE and transcribed automatically so report drafts are available within five minutes of an incident ending.

Use Multiple Transcripts

Officers can select multiple video evidence transcripts, including footage from other officers, to create a single draft report narrative.

Required Human Review and Sign-Off

Officers must review their reports, fill in the blanks and sign off on the accuracy of each report before submitting.

Third-Person Report Formatting

Agencies can enable third-person report generation to match their reporting standards and reduce the need for manual edits.

Axon Evidence Integration

Generate and edit report drafts inside the Axon Evidence report-writer tool and then easily copy to your third-party RMS.

Restrict by Incident Type

Agencies can restrict Draft One usage by incident type, charge level, or whether an arrest was made.

Audio-Only Input

Report drafts are generated directly from video and audio transcripts, then strengthened with officer-added context. Creativity is turned off to prevent speculation or embellishment, so every draft reflects only the evidence and the officer's narration.

Side-by-Side Transcript View

Compare your generated draft with the original transcript and associated video in a single view for quick cross-referencing to verify details and streamline report finalization.

Data Security

Agency data is always secured within the encrypted Axon Network; no transcripts or reports will be shared outside of your agency.

Mixed-Language Support

Draft One can process mixed English and Spanish audio to generate a draft report in English without the need for manual translation.

Officer Training

Training resources are integrated throughout the Draft One application and available in Axon Academy, with additional training options available for your agency.

Auto-Inserted Ranks

Officer ranks are automatically populated in generated drafts using assigned ranks from agency settings, ensuring consistency across every report.

Compatible with Your Third-Party RMS

Draft One works side-by-side with many different records management systems, so your officers can easily insert reports into your agency's RMS solution.
