



Adaptive Control Instructor Course

Host Request Requirements

Important Notes

The following outlines the space, facility, and equipment requirements to host an Adaptive Control Instructor Course. Submission of a host request does not guarantee course approval or scheduling. All host facilities are subject to review and approval by Axon, and courses are not considered confirmed until formally approved and scheduled by Axon. Clear photos of the training facility (including mat or training areas, classroom space, and any optional tactical or scenario-based spaces) are required as part of the host request form submission process.

Classroom Space

1. A classroom setting large enough for 30-35 students to view the PowerPoint presentation.
 - Projector, large display, or monitor capable of supporting video-based presentations
 - Screen (if using projector)
 - Speakers or audio system suitable for instructional presentations
 - Internet access

Practical Training Space

1. A large mat room or training area suitable for conducting hands-on practical training that includes ground-based exercises.
 - Access to training mats that fully cover the training area and are appropriate for repeated ground contact, partner-based movement, and physical control techniques.
 - Sufficient mat coverage to allow participants to safely train on the ground, including transitions, positioning, and controlled physical engagement.
 - Open floor space that allows for unrestricted movement and safe participation.
 - Flooring and environment appropriate for sustained physical activity.

Tactical / Scenario Training Space

(Optional)

1. Access to tactical, scenario-based, or situational training spaces (such as rooms or buildings used for scenario training) is optional.
2. If available, hosts should describe these spaces and include photos as part of the host request submission.
3. Availability of scenario-based training spaces may enhance course delivery and may be considered during course planning; however, these spaces are not required for course approval.

Facility Layout, Access, and Logistics

1. Classroom, mat/training areas, and any additional training spaces should be located within the same facility or general area.
 - If transportation between training spaces is required, this must be identified in advance and is subject to review and approval.
2. A basic first aid kit must be readily available in or near the training area, and hosts should plan to provide access to drinking water for participants throughout the training day.
 - Light refreshments (such as coffee or soda) are recommended but not required.
