

Fire protection management checklist

Before the impairment

- □ Stop any hazardous activities (like cutting, welding, or hot work)
- Notify the local fire department about the impairment
- □ Notify the alarm monitoring company and provide the expected duration
- □ Submit EMC's Fire Sprinkler System Valve Closing Notice
- □ Inform facility management and the emergency response team
- Communicate with affected employees
- Close fire doors in the impacted area
- Place extra fire extinguishers where needed
- □ Set up a fire watch
- □ Assign someone to reopen fire protection valves if a fire occurs
- □ Attach an impairment tag to the affected systems and control valves (contact your local fire sprinkler contractor for tag)

After the impairment

- □ Confirm the system is fully operational and re-locked in the open position
- □ Restore all alarm services
- □ Notify everyone who was previously informed (fire department, alarm monitoring company, and EMC via the Fire Sprinkler System Valve Reopening Notice)
- □ Reopen fire doors

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
