

Biogen Saves \$100,000 and 1,400 hours with JoVE

CHALLENGE

Typically, training each lab member on a new technique takes 36 hours. If no training resources are available, Dr. Sriperumbudur, Director of the In-Vivo Resource Center, must send a staff member to a remote lab to learn the technique. This process adds an average of 32 extra hours and \$4,600 in travel and lodging costs-just to learn a single technique.
