

# How to Clean Watersafe Floors

## WHEN TO CLEAN

### YOUR MAIN GOAL:

Remove dirt and debris that could damage your floor or may be hard to clean up later

### RIGHT AWAY - SPILLS

Wipe up spills with a rag or paper towels. Stains and grime will get harder to clean the longer they stay on the floor.

### WEEKLY - HIGH TRAFFIC AREAS

Spray and mop once per week or more as needed. High traffic areas (kitchens, hallways, entryways and living areas) need the most attention.

### AS NEEDED - LOW TRAFFIC AREAS

Clean low traffic areas like bedrooms, extra bathrooms, and guest rooms as needed.

#### WHAT TO USE

- MICROFIBER DUSTING PAD
- VACUUM OR BROOM
- MICROFIBER CLEANING PAD
- HARDWOOD SAFE CLEANER

#### WHAT TO AVOID

- WET MOPS
- STEAM MOPS
- SUPERMARKET OIL SOAPS, WAXES, AND POLISHES
- STRAIGHT OR DILUTED AMMONIA OR ALKALINE PRODUCTS

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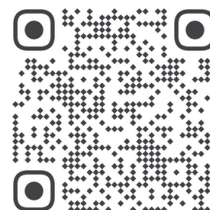
