

Multi-zone capability

Amp Multi delivers 125 watts per amplifier channel into eight outputs, assignable to any zone, giving you complete flexibility in system design. Different zones can be configured to operate independently, or a single zone can be configured with multiple outputs. For even larger installations, integrators can configure multiple units to a single zone and still benefit from the same straightforward setup and workflow, all managed through the Sonos app. Users can easily change audio sources and content, ensuring a streamlined and consistent experience.



Innovation inside and out

Amp Multi delivers premium quality sound in a compact, durable, and power-efficient design. Housed in a thermally-optimized, rack-friendly chassis, advanced GaN technology, Class D amplification, and post-filter feedback (PFFB) ensure exceptional audio quality and performance.


GaN is a game-changer in power electronics, offering faster, more efficient transistors than traditional silicon. This leads to significant energy savings and much lower heat generation without compromising power. Consequently, Amp Multi features a compact, entirely fanless, convection-cooled design that consumes less than 5.5W of power at idle (with WiFi disabled).

PFFB delivers outstanding audio quality through real-time signal correction. By continuously monitoring the output signal against the input, it enhances clarity, precision, and control. This reduces distortion and ensures consistent results across varying speaker loads.

ProTune manual sound controls

Amp Multi gives installers complete control over the sound in every zone. Each output can be independently tuned using a comprehensive 10-band parametric EQ, allowing precise adjustment of gain, frequency, and bandwidth along with input gain and delay offset. This level of granularity lets professionals fine-tune systems to suit any speaker, placement, or acoustic environment — ensuring the best possible audio performance in every room. Whether compensating for reflective surfaces, tight corners, or asymmetrical layouts, the built-in tools provide the flexibility and control needed for truly bespoke installations, no matter the brand of loudspeaker or room type.



Optimize Sonos Speakers


When paired with Sonos Architectural speakers, Amp Multi unlocks an advanced optimization feature. The amplifier detects connected Sonos speakers and automatically applies custom EQ profiles, limiter settings, and DSP tuning to maximize performance and protect the system. This ensures rich, balanced audio with smooth dynamics across the frequency range. The Optimize Sonos Speakers feature enables Amp Multi to safely drive loads down to 2.67 ohms, allowing up to three speakers per output channel. That means a single unit can power up to 24 speakers — perfect for large, distributed installations. It's a smarter, more efficient way to deliver consistent, high-quality sound at scale.

Amp Multi Rack Mount (sold separately)

The innovative Rack Mount is an elegant solution that streamlines installations. Its revolutionary design maximizes rack density and ensures optimal airflow by creating space above and below each unit, eliminating the need for additional vent panels.

Amp Multi's flat back design and recessed connectors make adding the rack mount easy and streamlines cable management. By standing the unit on its back, the Rack Mount simply slides over the front of the device for installation into a standard 19-inch rack. The entire operation uses just eight screws. It's an effective, quiet, and space-efficient solution that simplifies every stage of the install.

Streamlined setup

Setting up Amp Multi is fast, intuitive, and completely app-driven. Using the Sonos app, installers can configure zones, assign outputs, manage sources, and view system status — all from one place.

Each unit emits an audible chirp for quick identification in the app, removing the need for manual PIN entry. Front and rear LEDs clearly indicate setup mode, providing real-time visual feedback throughout installation. With ambient light sensing and intuitive fault diagnostics, Amp Multi simplifies even complex multi-zone projects.

Combined with the Sonos app's powerful control interface, it saves time and delivers a truly seamless setup experience.

Flexible connections

Each Amp Multi includes two external inputs, assignable to any zone. A dedicated subwoofer output allows easy integration of a powered sub, or assign a wireless Sonos Sub to each zone for clean bass delivery.

Each Amp Multi can use its eight outputs to drive up to 24 passive loudspeakers.






Larger systems

You can stream to up to 32 audio zones within a Sonos system, and Amp Multi is built to scale that flexibility into large installations. Integrators can configure systems in multiple ways: deploy up to 32 units with one zone each, run up to eight units with four zones each, or combine devices within a single zone — up to 16 units per zone, for maximum power and coverage.

Using subwoofers

Amp Multi has a dedicated line level subwoofer output. This can be assigned to any one of the four zones.

Using wireless subs with zones

Amp Multi lets you use up to four subs in total, one per zone. You can use Sonos wireless subs in any zone, and the single wired sub output can be assigned to one zone of your choice in place of a wireless sub.
