

## TIP Supplemental Policy on Copyright Options for Specifications

("Supplemental Copyright Policy")

The TIP IPR Policy, the current version of which may be found at <a href="https://telecominfraproject.com/wp-content/uploads/sites/12/2016/09/IPR-Policy-Adopted-May-27-2016.pdf">https://telecominfraproject.com/wp-content/uploads/sites/12/2016/09/IPR-Policy-Adopted-May-27-2016.pdf</a>, specifies that Final Specifications (as defined in the IPR Policy) may be licensed under the Creative Commons Attribution License, or the copyright to the Final Specification may be released to the public domain. The IPR Policy also states that any other choice must be approved by the TIP Board of Directors. The purpose of this Supplemental Copyright Policy is to provide additional choices that TIP Project Groups (PGs) may select for the release of Final Specifications. Any choice selected by a PG must be reflected in the PG Charter and approved by the Board in accordance with TIP's Organizational Documents, which can be found at <a href="https://telecominfraproject.com/organizational-documents/">https://telecominfraproject.com/organizational-documents/</a>. This Supplemental Copyright Policy may be amended-from time-to-time by the addition of other options and such other options will become effective as part of this Supplemental Copyright Policy upon approval by the Board and the publication of the amended Supplemental Copyright Policy with TIP's other Organizational Documents.
